Conditions of play

- Staff requests must be observed at all times. The Course Controller and their staff have the right to withdraw a player's invitation to enter and/or continue to play on the course.
- Green fees must be paid before play. Refunds cannot be given after the commencement of play, but credits can be given at management discretion.
- Each player must have a set of golf clubs and a bag.
 Sharing is not permitted.
- Players must repair divots on fairways and pitch marks on greens.
- Golfers must maintain the pace of play. Your group's position is behind the group in front of you.
- Golf bags/carts/buggies/trolleys must be kept at least 2m from the tees and greens at all times.
- 7. Motorised carts must not be driven through the bush.
- Maximum 4 players per group. Smaller groups will be paired. Players must join others when asked to do so.
- 9. Players arriving late may lose their place on the field.
- 10. Dress standards are a shirt or blouse, shorts, trousers or skirt, and enclosed shoes. Singlets, cut-off jeans, thongs, sandals, or work boots are not permitted.
- 11. Children in prams, pushchairs, or carried are not permitted on the golf course.
- 12. All players should conduct themselves in a manner that demonstrates courtesy and sportsmanship at all times. Unacceptable behaviour includes:
 - · Throwing clubs
 - · Shouting, swearing, or making unnecessary noise
 - · Damaging or littering the course. Use the bins provided.
 - Deliberately abusing, distracting, or provoking fellow players or staff.

Local Rules (in conjunction with the Rules of Golf)

- · Entry into any water hazard is prohibited.
- Preferred lies may be taken on the fairway in play, up to one scorecard length.
- All vehicle paths are to be treated as G.U.R. Staked trees/shrubs, bunker rake holders, temporary markers, fairway distance markers, standing water, animal holes, sprinkler heads, and valve boxes are abnormal course conditions / immovable obstructions, and relief can also be taken under Rule 16.1.
- A ball lying on any green other than the one being played MUST be lifted and dropped no nearer the hole.
 No penalty.
- Out-of-bounds are marked with white stakes and white lines.

Safety

- Ensure no one is standing close by or in a position to be hit by the club, ball, or any stones or twigs, etc. when they make a stroke or practice swing.
- Players should not play until the players in front are out of range.
- 3.If a ball is played in a direction where there is a danger of hitting someone, shout a warning of "FORE LEFT" or "FORE RIGHT", and indicate direction with your arm.
- Unless otherwise instructed, players should not continue play when course staff are undertaking course works in the same area.
- The course is irrigated with wastewater. Golfers should carry their own drinking water.
